

Why the Stillwater Community Center Foundation is Involved

- Donations will be received and administered by the Stillwater Community Center Foundation (SCCF), a 501(c)(3) organization per agreement with major donor "Kicker" and the City of Stillwater
- The Block 34 Architecture and Development Committee is a committee under the Stillwater Community Center Foundation and is charged with securing funding for development of the block as well as guidance and oversight for changes/modifications upon completion of initial construction. The committee was formed under agreement with City of Stillwater, "Kicker" and the SCCF.
- Also, per agreement with "Kicker" and the City of Stillwater, the SCCF will deliver at least 14 music programs per year on the Kicker Sound Stage and Saturday morning programs year around, for ten years. Also, per agreement, shows will move into the Stillwater Community Center Theater if weather requires.
- "Kicker" (aka. Stillwater Designs) is the largest and primary donor and source of funds for the Block 34 project.
